Actor's hotrod mission comes from the heart

Paul Le Mat is forever young in the 1973 film "American Graffiti." He played John Milner, a drag-racing greaser on his high school graduation night in 1962.

Talking on the phone from Sacramento last week, where he was attending the Autorama car show, Mr. Le Mat said he was only "almost as tough, and almost as cool" as that character.

Today, he lives in San Fernando Valley, Calif. Now in his 60s, Mr. Le Mat has furthered his association with hot rods and classic cars, traveling all over the country attending car shows. He also filmed a documentary called "Hot Rods Across America." And soon, Mr. Le Mat will be coming to a car show near you. Look for him on Feb. 20 at Supercruise USA, held on the Charlotte County Fairgrounds in Port Charlotte.

Hundreds of vehicles, including a replica of the yellow '32 Ford coupe Mr. Le Mat raced in the film, will be on display from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Mr. Le Mat will also autograph photos and posters, with all proceeds going to the Bread of Life Mission in Punta Gorda. Judy Jones operates a homeless shelter there with a Christian message.
